

August UOVA Monthly Meeting Minutes

Reviewed Minutes from July – motion to accept by Traci and second by Lyndsey.

Reviewed Profit & Loss for July. Everything looks good. Financials are accepted.

Old/New Business:

It has been proposed that we work with the U of U again to support a few of their games. Specifically 9/7 and 9/9. UOVA members and their family/friends can get admission for only \$2. We will be asking Casey Adams to think about doing a half-time demonstration of the doubles format of volleyball with a partner. Sundi motions to approve and Darian seconds the support for this.

Rules in Question:

- Toss of serve rule is addressed. We are going to double check, but are pretty sure that you are only allowed one toss. Juniors will be allowed a second toss if necessary.
- Playing boundaries are discussed. If there are no antenna, the ball must cross the net within the imaginary lines created by the poles instead.
- NCAA rules regarding players eligibility to accept prizes if they are in high school or playing college. We will need to be more clear on this with the directors, and make sure they have a copy of the rules regarding this for next year.
- Tournament Format changes after the fact by players – this will not be tolerated. If a player/pool changes format, they can play out their pool but will be ineligible to advance and contend for prizes. The entire pool will be unable to advance, even if only one player decided to make the change. Any possible changes should be taken up with the director. This will be posted clearly in next year's rule book.
- Forfeiture of games – this will also not be accepted. If a team voluntarily forfeits a game for any reason (other than injury/illness), they will immediately be eliminated from further play. If an illness or injury is the cause, it must be taken up immediately to the director. At the director's discretion, they can be eliminated and/or be unable to content for prizes, or the order of the games can be rearranged to meet their needs.

Mesquite tournament is coming up soon. Traci will be in charge of it and will ask for help from the Board on an as-needed basis. Several people have indicated they plan to attend.

Cathy Hammond has petitioned the Board for permission to remain in A even though she has won two A. The Board denies her petition. For her purposes (playing in Mesquite) the Board will help her find other solutions that still enable her to come play. Motion to deny her request is made by Darian, second by Sundi. Traci will inform her.
